Your child should read **one** novel/book within his/her ZPD level and complete **4 hours of I-Ready Reading and 4 hours of I-Ready Math** (Deadline for I-Ready is July 20, 2018).

After reading the book, your child must choose a performance task project listed on the summer reading website. Each one of these projects is designed to encourage your child to think critically about the books read, as well as to spark his/her creativity and individuality. AR tests may not be taken on the book until the academic school year begins.

Projects are due August 22, 2018. An extra credit participation grade will be given for each component of the summer assignments completed (i.e. performance task, I-Ready Reading, I-Ready Math)
